

Botox Sudbury

Botox Sudbury - Skin wrinkles are by definition a ridge, crease or fold in the skin. The wrinkles of the skin often appear as a result of aging, comprising: the extended immersion of the skin in water or glycation. The wrinkling of the skin is a result of habitual facial expressions, sun damage, aging, poor hydration, smoking and various other factors. Skin wrinkles in the water because of extended water exposure which causes the outer layer of skin to absorb water. Depletion of water in the body as with dehydration also can cause the puckering of the skin. Cortisol is one more element that leads to degradation of skin collagen.

To be able to treat wrinkles and different skin depressions, dermal fillers are often used. There are products which are injectable into the soft tissues. Dermal fillers are designed to enable injection into the skin for purposes of enhancing the skins' appearance. The most well-known products are based on hyaluronic acid.

Botulinum Toxin

The neurotoxin protein, botulinum toxin, is made by the bacterium *Clostridium botulinum*. The most popular kind of botulinum toxin is referred to as onabotulinumtoxinA or "Botox". This specific type of botulinum toxin is made by Allergan Inc. for both therapeutic and cosmetic usage. Botox is utilized in the treatment of migraine headache and spasmodic dystonia or spasmodic torticollis which is a neuromuscular disorder that involves the head and neck. Botox has lots of uses together with its cosmetic application.

In the year 2009, American people now had a new available form of botulinum toxin. This new form, made by Ipsen, is known as abotulinumtoxinA or Dysport. It has been given approval by the FDA and is now made use of to remedy glabellar lines in adults along with cervical dystonia. Dysport and Botox however, are not the same since the molecular structure of the two drugs is different.

The Botulinum toxin can treat lots of wrinkles by immobilizing or relaxing the muscles which lead to wrinkles. This toxin is not appropriate for the remedy of all wrinkles, as is seen with glabellar lines, that take place between the eyebrows in adults. Whatever other use of this toxin is considered "off-label" use and is not approved by the FDA.
